# asparagus ALERTI

Mexican volume should increase into next week and then the market is expected to decline. Quality is good from both growing regions, but larger sizing is more available.

Mexican supplies have tightened from limited harvesting from rain issues coupled with a national holiday. Expect shortages on all sizes and grades into next week until the pipeline is replenished. The market has strengthened across the board and category #2 fruit continues to



# beans-green ALERTI

Eastern supplies will remain limited for a few weeks. Damage is being assessed from Hurricane Helene. Western supplies are very limited from CA, with Eastern Mexico volume a month away.



### berriesblackberry, blueberry & raspberry

ALERT! Blackberry supplies are on the decline through October. Quality

ALERT! is good with a few occasional issues. Markets are higher. Blueberry supplies are light. Quality is good on fruit from Peru and markets are steady. Raspberry supplies are increasina. Quality is good and markets are lower.



# berries- ALERTI strawberry

Supplies are improving with both Southern and Central CA in production, but a heat wave is hitting both areas this week. We are monitorina quality daily to gauge the extent of the damage. Markets are steady.



#### broccoli & cauliflower

The **broccoli** market is a little active as quality issues have reduced yields keeping volume tight and just meeting demand. The **cauliflower** market is steady, but with some quality issues affecting yields that could move the market up as supplies are just moderate currently.



# celery

The market is mostly steady to a bit higher on moderate supplies. Quality has been good.



# citrus-lemons, ALERTI oranges & limes

**Lemon** demand is steady as different areas wind down and begin. Fruit quality is good. The **lime** market has begun to de-escalate. The new crop is peaking on small fruit and quality has improved. Large sizes are extremely limited, and quality will be adequate at best.





#### 1.BANANAS

Supplies are good. We do not see any issues from the port strike, but we are monitoring daily for updates.

### 2.BROCCOLINI® ALERT!

Weather has affected growth, and supplies are struggling to keep up with demand.

# 3.CORN ALERT!

Western corn is on alert from limited supplies and mostly white corn availability.

#### 4.MUSHROOMS

ALERT!

Supplies are lighter industrywide, particularly on white mushooms from some suppliers.

# 5.ONIONS—GREEN ALERT!

The market is high as supplies remain short, but better production is expected in the next 7-10 days.

# Outlook

#### WEST COAST

The 6-10 day outlook expects average temps for the area and mostly normal precipitation for this time of year.

#### **EAST COAST**

The 6-10 day outlook expects mostly below average temps for most of the Southeast. Precipitation is expected FL expecting above average for this time of year.

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ALERT! Orange demand continues and supplies remain limited. The Valencia harvest is finished for the season with large fruit limited and quality a challenge. Import volume will be limited until the start of CA navel season in late October. Flexibility on size and arade is needed as demand exceeds supplies.




# melonshoneydew & cantaloupe

Eastern green bells are limited, quality is fair, and markets are increasing. Red and yellow bells are extremely limited. Western green bell pepper supplies are limited with an increasing market. Colored pepper volume is better, but auality issues are creating a two-tiered market.



# eggplant

Eastern eggplant supply is good, quality is good, and the market is lower. Expect the market to increase in a few weeks due to hurricane damage causing a shortage. Western product is limited due to weather out of Mexico; CA supplies are limited with just fair quality.



#### potatoes

Supplies are good on the new crop. Sizing is running large with some growers being limited on small sizes. Quality is good. Markets are lower on all sizes.
